Incorporated NPO Chinese Medical Association in Japan

The Chinese Medical Association (CMAJ) of Japan is the first voluntary organization of Chinese physicians in Japan, and was established on October 21, 2006. The qualification of the incorporated nonprofit organization is recognized by the Cabinet Prime Minister's Office, and it was previously named Incorporated NPO Chinese Medical Association in Japan on June 1, 2007.

The CMAJ's missions are: providing leadership and consultants sharing medical information with members, facilitating exchange of medical information with all Japanese medical association for development of medical science in both China and Japan, consultation as a channel and a bridge for Chinese professionals to communicate with other organizations and persons in Japan, organizing international symposiums, and attending International Conferences to assist the connection between clinical and research. In order to promote the interchange and connection between Japan and China in the field of medicine, utilizing skills of Chinese doctors to contribute professionally for Japan. The CMAJ has and will be confronting the issues of spreading medical and pharmaceutical knowledge, and setting up the medical information windows.

Wuhan Institute of Virology, Chinese Academy of Sciences

Wuhan Institute of Virology, Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS) which is the institution for the management of the nation's scientific research, was founded in 1956. It is the only institute in the country focused exclusively on carrying out fundamental research in general virology. Since it was selected as one of the institutes to participate in the CAS Knowledge Innovation Program in 2002 and again in 2006, its research has expanded from general virology to encompass clinical related virology and research on emerging disease. In 2005, the insitution set up the Virus Resource and Bioinformatics Centre of China with University of Wu Han. It owns the State Key Laboratory of Virology and the Joint Laboratory of Invertebrate Virology a HIV pre-screening Laboratory and the Hubei Engineering and Technology Research Center for Viral Diseases.

The Japan Society for the Promotion of Science

The Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), or Gakushin for short, is an independent administrative institution, established by way of a national law for the purpose of contributing to the advancement of science in all fields of the natural and social sciences and the humanities. JSPS plays a pivotal role in the administration of a wide spectrum of Japan's scientific and academic programs. While working within the broad framework of government policies established to promote scientific advancement, JSPS carries out its programs in a manner flexible to the needs of the participating scientists.

JSPS was founded in 1932 as a non-profit foundation through an endowment granted by Emperor Showa. JSPS started an invitation program with CAMS, inviting young medical scientists from China. This program is funded by the Japanese pharmaceutical companies: Ono Pharmaceutical Co. Ltd., and Sumitomo Pharmaceutical Co. Ltd. This program plans to build a sustaining network between the countries of China and Japan by financially supporting cooperative research, conferences and seminars.

National Institute of Infectious Diseases

To stimulate basic and applied research work and to lead in development and quality control of antibiotics and vaccines, the National Institute of Infectious Diseases (renamed from the National Institute of Health in 1997) attached to the Ministry of Health and Welfare, was established in 1947, when contagious diseases control was an urgent problem in Japan.

The Institute aims at carrying out extensive and original research projects on a variety of contagious diseases from the standpoint of preventive medicine, improving human health and welfare by suppressing infectious diseases, and clarifying and supporting the scientific background of health and medical administration of the country.

These functions may be summarized into 1) research activities, 2) reference services for infectious diseases, 3) surveillance of infectious diseases, 4) national control tests and other tests, 5) international cooperation, and 6) training activities.
